
Map Skills Study Guide

- What are maps? Maps are tools that help you find places. They are like pictures of a place.
- What is a compass rose? The compass rose shows the directions on the map.
- What are symbols on a map? Symbols are pictures that stand for the real thing on a map.
- What is a map key? The map key tells you what the symbols stand for on a map.
- What are the cardinal directions? The cardinal directions are north, south, east, and west.
- What are the intermediate directions? The intermediate directions are northeast, northwest, southeast, and southwest.


