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## Social Studies Standard:

- The president is the leader of our country, United States of America.
- The president lives and works in the White House.
- Our country's capital city is Washington, D. C.
- The White House is in Washington, D. C.
- Some jobs of the president are: being in charge of the military, signing laws for our country, and helping keep peace with other countries.
- The governor is the leader of the state.
- Our state is Georgia.
- The governor works in the State Capitol Building which is in the state's capital city.
- Atlanta is Georgia's capital city.
- Some jobs of the governor are: signing laws for the state, being in charge of the school's education (what is taught in the schools), and in building roads for the state.
- The mayor or city commissioner is the leader of the city.
- Our school, Buford Academy, is in the city of Buford.
- The mayor or city commissioner works at City Hall.
- Some jobs of the mayor of city commissioner are: signing laws for the city, being in charge of the fire and police department for the city, and in building schools for the city.
