

We will also learn how to use a compass rose, map key, and letter/number grids. Listed below is the Social Studies Map Skill Goal for our unit. Also included is important vocabulary and examples of what we are learning about. Happy Learning!

Social Studies Map Skills Goal:

The student will use maps to retrieve social studies information.

- 1. Maps are tools that help you find places. They are like pictures of a place.
- 2. The **compass rose** shows the directions on the map.
- 3. Symbols are pictures that stand for the real thing on a map.
- 4. The **map key** tells you what the symbols stand for on a map.
- 5. The cardinal directions are north, south, east, and west.
- 6. The **intermediate directions** are northeast, northwest, southeast, and southwest.
 - Identify where each direction is on the compass rose
- 7. Read the Lakeside Campground Map:
 - Using the map key, identify each symbol on the map.
 - The tents are <u>east</u> of the cabins. The campfire is <u>south</u> of the tents.
 - Locate where each direction is on the map using the compass rose above.



8. Read the map key and grid:

- The airport is at C, 5.
- The school is at A, 1.
- The lake is at D, 4.

The post office is at B, 1.
