- How did Tomochichi show that he was <u>honest</u> and <u>trustworthy</u>? He kept his promise to give the land to James Oglethorpe for the new city. He also helped make peace treaties so Indians and settlers worked together and lived in peace.
- Why did Oglethorpe and Tomochichi have a difficult time communicating? They spoke different languages. Oglethorpe spoke English, and Tomochici spoke Creek.
- What does civility mean? Civility means treating others with respect and kindness.
- How did Oglethorpe and Tomochichi show civility? They showed civility as they kept their word about being peaceful with each other and being kind towards each other.
- Who helped Oglethorpe and Tomochichi communicate with each other? Mary Musgrove
- What two languages did Mary Musgrove speak? English because her father was an English trader; Creek because her mother was a Creek Indian.
- What job did Mary Musgrove and her husband have? They ran a trading post between the Creek Indians and English settlers.
- What does <u>dependability</u> mean? Dependability means a person can be trusted to do what he or she promised to do.
- How was Mary Musgrove dependable? The Creek and English knew they could trust her when she helped them speak with each other.
- How can you tell Oglethorpe and Tomochichi became friends? Tomochichi went back to England with Oglethorpe to meet King George II and other English leaders.
